



Dog Walking Etiquette



A dog on lead



A dog with any sign on its coat/lead



A dog with a muzzle

If you see a dog with any one of the above STOP! CALL YOUR DOGS BACK!

And keep your dogs onlead/ under control until passed

It really important not to let your dogs go up to any dogs on lead with out first checking with their owner, especially if they have any signage on their leads/ coats or are muzzled.

Dogs could be on lead for a number of reasons including: ~In season ~recovering from an operation ~ reactive/ sensitive to people/ dogs/ bikes/ cars ~In training ~ Assistance dogs etc.

You can be prosecuted for your dog being out of control in a public place under section 3 of the Dangerous dogs act 1991. This includes not being able to call your dog back!
